Billing an EAP

- You <u>cannot</u> bill a 90791 for an EAP. So, even for the first appointment, bill ONLY 90834 or 90847 (or 90846, if the client is not present, such as for a child).
- Your first visit (and all EAP visits) use the Mobile Note Therapy Progress Note
 WITHOUT Measures so that none of the Intake Measures are pulled into the
 Note.
- You can still view the rough copies of the Measures in PDF form in Uninitialed Documents so you can get an idea of what is going on with the client.
- When you are done with the last EAP visit, you would need to alert us via this
 original intake email so that we can switch the account over to the regular
 insurance.
- Your first visit using insurance would be billed as a 90791 and you would do a
 Mobile Note Intake Note.
- To view how many visits are authorized, look in Patients Auths and you will see the number of visits in the Remaining column.
- Please ask if you have questions, as EAP's can be a little confusing.
